The mixed-use Archer Towers I development will offer 605 apartments for households of various incomes as well as 225 below-grade parking spots and retail space on the ground floor. This first of two planned towers on the site will be 542,000 square feet with a height of 25 stories. The development is within walking distance to Jamaica Terminal, one of New York's busiest transit hubs.

The estimated cost of around \$300 million is only a fraction of what BRP Companies, the development's owner, plans to spend this year on projects. Crews broke ground on Phase 1 in April 2021, and the 450-unit Phase 2 is currently in the design stage, with a tentative construction date of April 2022.

Archer Towers isn't the typical apartment complex one might find in New York. The interior design is luxurious, featuring high-end finishes, vertical stack heat pumps and a floor-toceiling glass façade that completely encompasses the building's exterior. Richard Santosky, President of Skycore Builders, says the company doesn't distinguish between marketrate and affordable housing units when it's building.

"The project is designed as a marketrate building," he says. "Some of the units will rent for less, but their finishes will be the same."

Identical units allow every household to experience high-end living, regardless of their income. But in terms of saving money, consistent design just makes more sense. By keeping the unit finishes consistent, Skycore can drive down the cost of materials and complete the project in a more efficient manner. 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





work. KSW Mechanical will perform the HVAC work, and Horsepower Electric will be the electrician. Once Archer Towers is complete, the property will include fixtures from GFC Lighting Wholesalers.

The team at Skycore maintains high standards not just for their subcontractors, but for their own company. Santosky emphasizes the importance of builders and owners working in unison for the greater good of the project.

"We've established what we call an 'aligned relationship' with the developer...BRP is depending upon us to deliver high-quality projects on time, for a price that satisfies the demands of the financial models," Santosky says. "And then in return, we're depending on them to provide us work for the foreseeable future. It's a symbiotic relationship, and thus far, it's been highly successful."

Skycore looks forward to continuing to build mutually beneficial relationships with stakeholders on additional projects. The construction company is already working on two more mixed-use developments in New Rochelle, New York: 10 Commerce and 500 Main Street. Also coming this fall are 90Ninety, a 614-unit development in Jamaica, Queens, and The Arboretum on Long Island, a 62-acre development consisting of 292 units including 51



single-family homes, the balance being town-homes and flats. The project will also include a 7-acre arboretum with walking trails for the community.

"All these projects have one thing in common, [and] that's Skycore's dedication to striving for excellence," Santosky says. "When we as

the general contractor are aligned with both the subcontractors and developers as collaborative partners, we [are] able to be more open about problems. This candor and collaboration produce greater success. While we can never be perfect, we do have high expectations. We think that this mindset has made us better builders."
